Who are we?

The Arlington County Scholarship Fund for Teachers, Inc. is a community-wide, non-profit organization founded in 1955 to support individuals pursuing a career in education.

Who comprises the organization?

The ACSFfT is made up of representatives appointed by the

- County Council of PTAs
- Arlington Retired Teachers Association
- Arlington Education Association
- Arlington County Civic Federation
- Arlington School Board

plus several “at large” members from the community

What does the ACSFfT do?

The ACSFfT awards one-year scholarships of \$2,500 to outstanding students who are members of the June graduating class of Arlington County Public Schools, have indicated a genuine interest in the field of education, and plan a career in teaching or related professions such as school counselor or librarian.

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of student potential and desire to teach, as demonstrated in past activities, accomplishments, and future plans.

From 1955 to 2018, the ACSFfT has awarded 576 scholarships for a total of \$629,000.

How are the scholarship recipients selected?

Candidates must submit applications that include an essay about why they have chosen to enter the teaching or related profession and must be interviewed by the members of the organization.
